ENTRY INFORMATION

The tournament is open to any female golfer who will be 50 years of age or older on September 10, 2023, and who is a member of an Indiana golf club or ladies league that has paid 2023 dues to ISWGA. Participants will be paired with players of like handicaps and scores.

The entry fee (which includes 3 days of greens fees with a cart, luncheons on the 2nd & 3rd days and prizes) is \$ 200.00 and must be post-marked by Monday, Aug. 21, 2023. The first 112 players who enter will be accepted. The field is limited to the first 112 player entries received based on the postmark or delivery date if in person. Other entries beyond 112 will be placed on a waiting list in case of cancellations. Entries not accepted will be returned with checks. Any entrant who withdraws after August 28th will forfeit the entry fee (except those qualifying for USGA Senior Tournament). No refunds due to weather cancellations.

- Applicants must have an IGA / USGA approved handicap index
- Tournament handicap will be confirmed in Sept
- Appropriate golf attire is required
- Participants may use devices that measure distance only
- Participants must use riding carts
- No caddies or spectators allowed

USGA RULES APPLY TO ALL PLAY

PRACTICE ROUNDS: The fee for a practice round at Coyote Crossing is \$39.00, Monday through Friday or after noon on Sat or Sunday, which includes greens fee and a cart. Call (765) 497-1061 to schedule a tee time and mention you are practicing for the ISWGA tournament. Participation confirmation is required. Ladies will play from the navy tees during the tournament.

2023 TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE & AWARDS

Sunday, September 10

1:30pm Shotgun start, Stroke play

First 18-hole qualification round for flights, which includes contests for two-lady teams, four-lady teams and low putts.

Monday, September 11

9:00am Shotgun start, Stroke play

Second 18-hole qualification round for flights. At the luncheon after golf, Prizes are awarded for Super Senior Low Net & Gross, Legends Low Net, Medalist, Memorial Low Net, sixteen championship flight qualifiers, low putts, two-lady team and four-lady team.

Tuesday, September 12

9:00am Shotgun start, Stroke play

Third 18-hole round. Flights will be based on players' combined two-day qualification scores. At the luncheon after golf, prizes are awarded to the tournament champion and 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place low gross and net players in each flight.

TOURNAMENT AND LOCAL RULES will be distributed on the first day of the tournament.

TWO-LADY & FOUR-LADY TEAMS - These prizes are awarded to teams of players from the same club with the first day lowest combined gross score. Clubs with more than 3 entrants will only compete in the four-lady event.

SUPER SENIOR LOW NET & LOW GROSS - Any player who will be 66 years of age or older on Sept. 10, 2023 is eligible for these awards. These prizes are awarded to the players with the lowest 2-day gross and net scores.

LEGENDS LOW NET - Any player who will be 75 years of age or older on Sept. 10, 2023 is eligible for this award. The prize is awarded to the player with the lowest 2-day net score.

MEDALIST - This prize is awarded to the player with lowest 2-day gross score.

MEMORIAL LOW NET - This prize, established in memory of deceased participants, is awarded to the player with the lowest 2-day net score.
